The first Citizens Advice Bureau was formed in England in response to the prospect of World War II. Volunteers dealt with problems ranging from the loss of ration books, homelessness and evacuation. Mrs G Rushton initiated the opening of the first CABWA in 1963. Now we have 10 Branches throughout Western Australia teamed by volunteers who give their time to service their communities.
